STATEMENT OF DAVIDE PROSPERI

PRESIDENT OF THE FRATERNITY OF COMMUNION AND LIBERATION

Upon learning the news of Benedict XVI's death, Davide Prosperi issued the following statement:

"On behalf of the movement of Communion and Liberation, I express our deep sadness, though full of hope, and our moved condolences for Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI's ascent to Heaven. He was a true giant of faith and a fervent witness to the beauty of life marked by the encounter with Christ. He was an authentic father of the Church and also a devoted father of every man and woman of this age. In particular, he was certainly a loving father to those of us of Communion and Liberation. In a world confusedly searching for meaning in life, Benedict has indeed served the Church by showing everyone how, using his words, "the intelligence of faith has to become the intelligence of reality."
